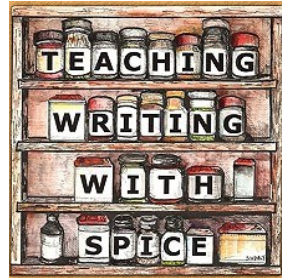


Teach Your Students How to Write with Spice for PARCC
